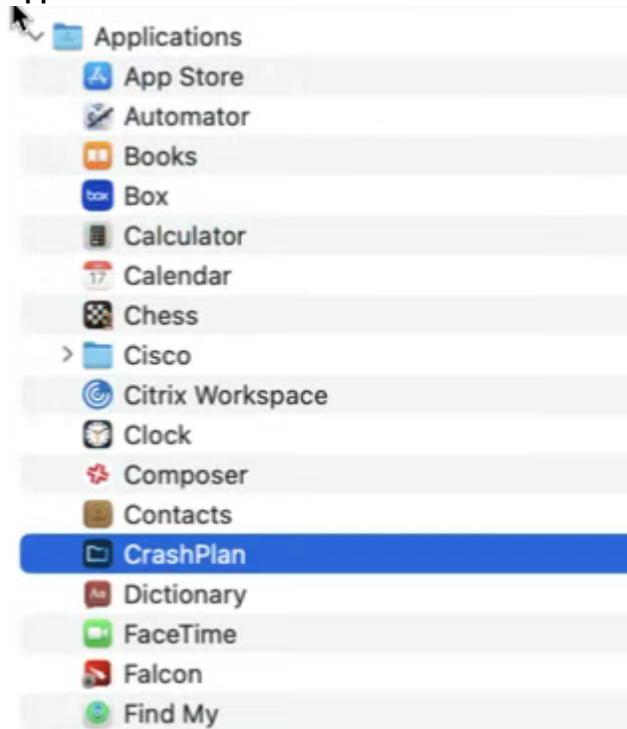


## CrashPlan macOS Setup

Verify if **CrashPlan** is installed on your computer by searching for the CrashPlan application in your **Applications** folder:



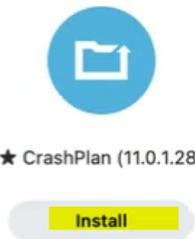
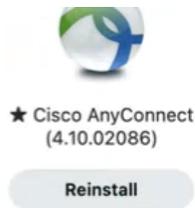
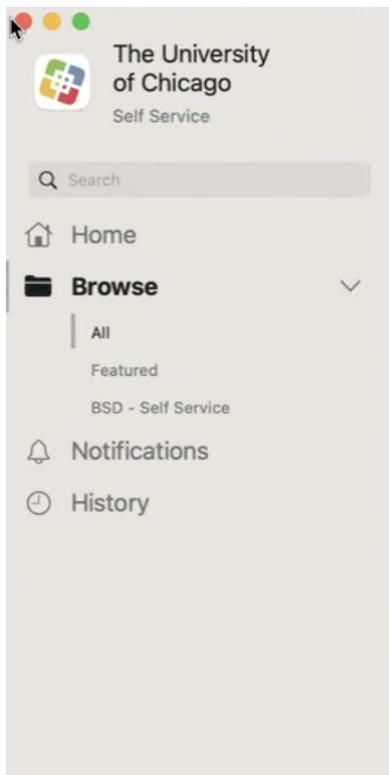
If CrashPlan is not installed, launch the “Self Service” application from your **Applications** folder:



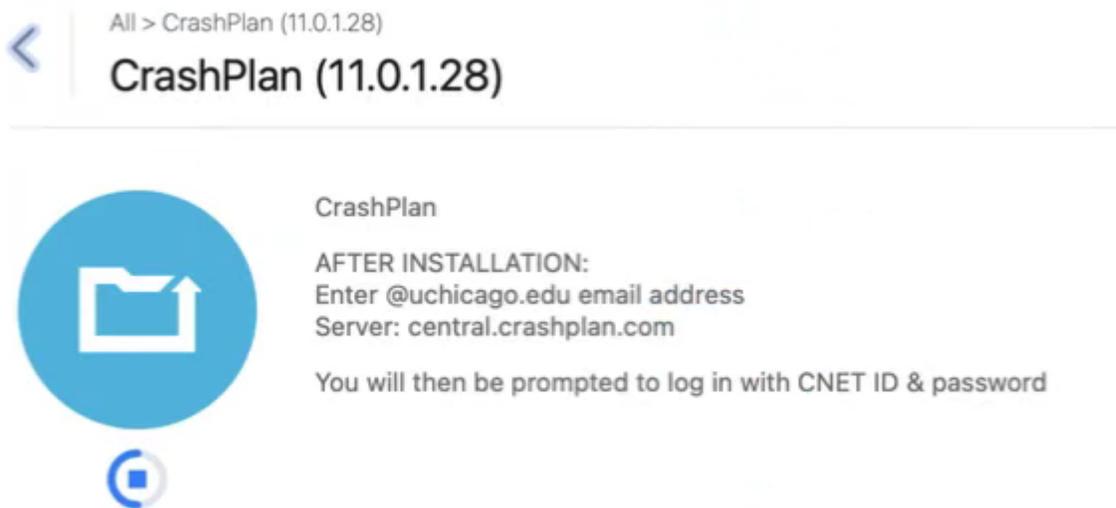
**Note:** If you don't see the Self-Service application, it likely means your mac is not fully managed by BSDIS DSS.

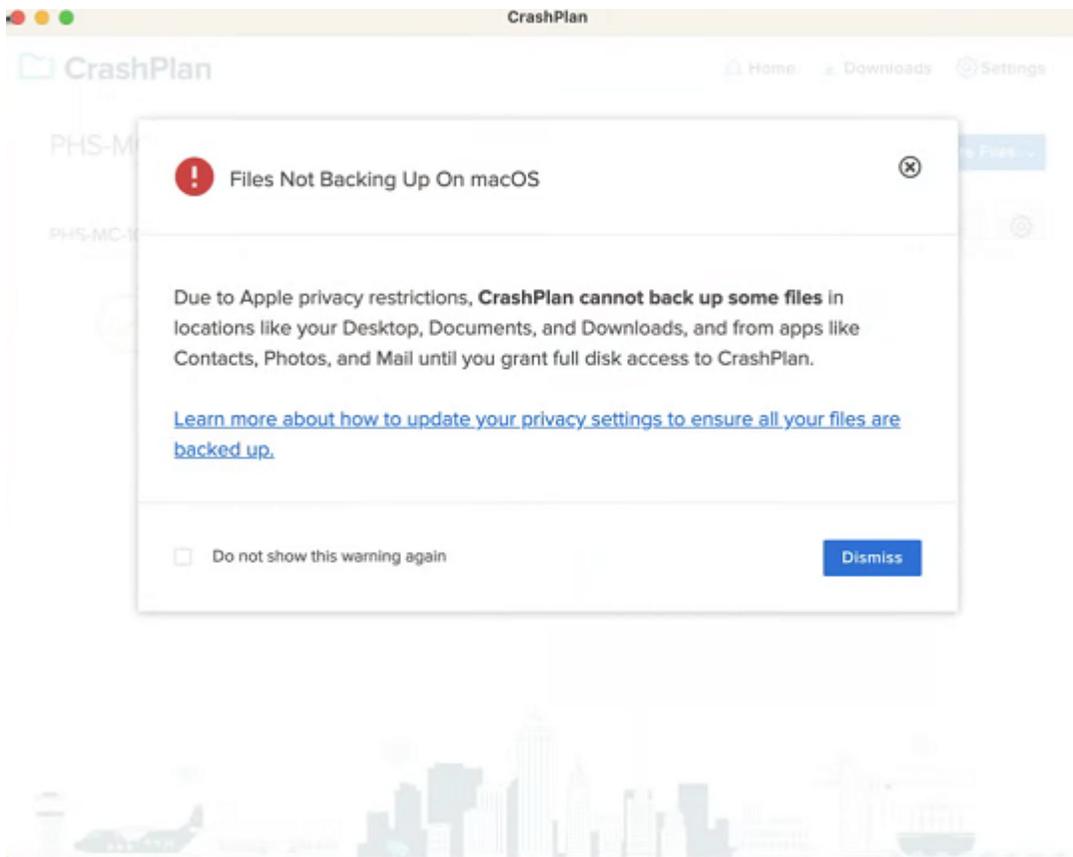

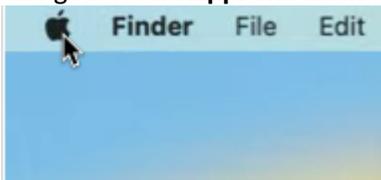

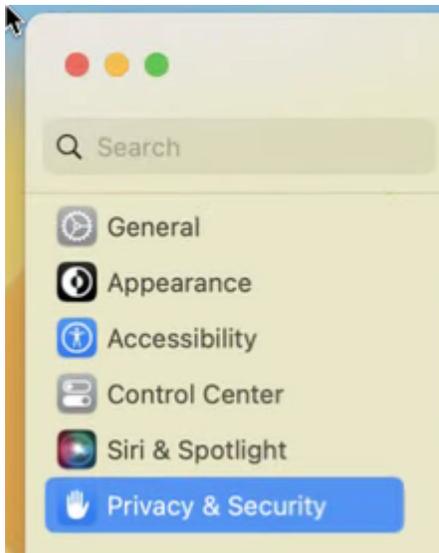
Navigate to the **Apple** menu in the upper left corner of the screen.



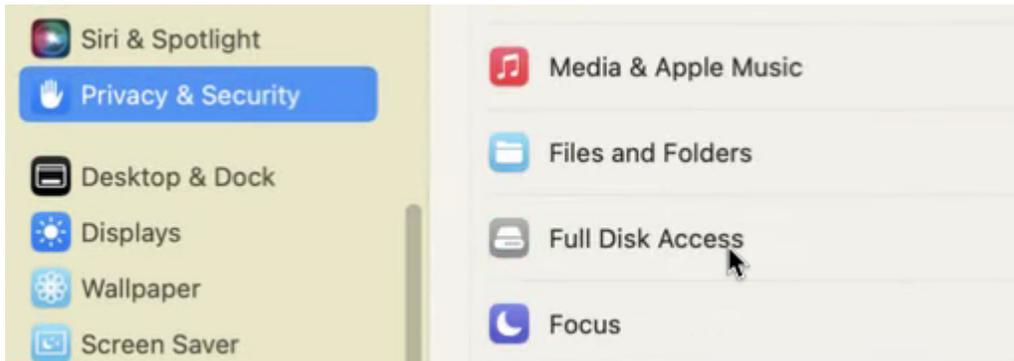
Select **System Settings** (in older MacOS software this is called **System Preferences**) from the menu.



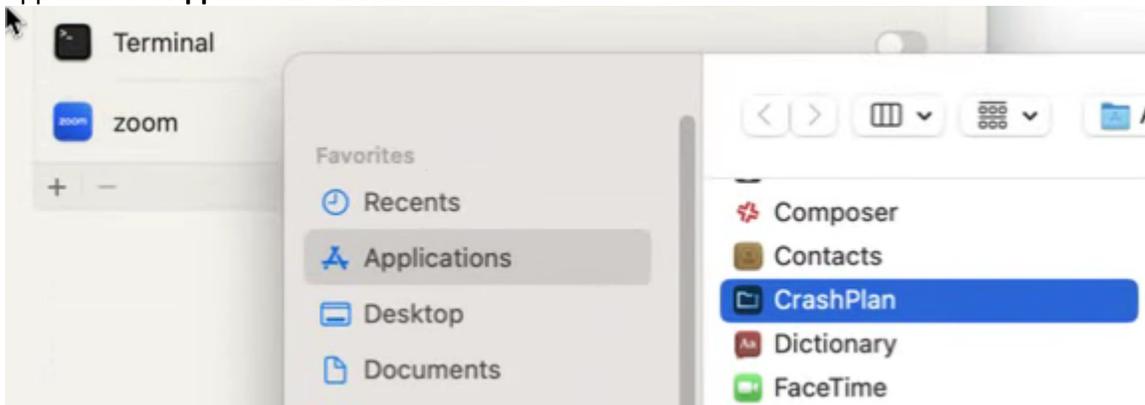
From the **System Settings** panel, click the **Security & Privacy** icon.



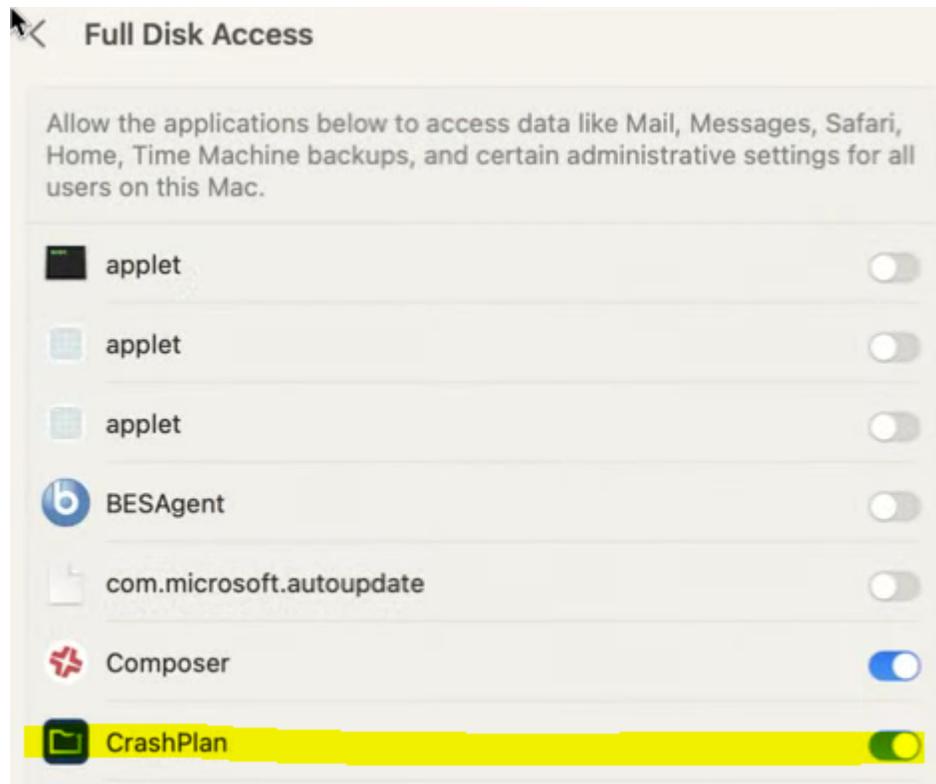
Select **Full Disk Access**:
